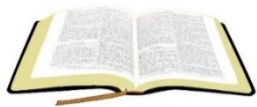
**Trinity's next Confirmation Class will be** on Sunday, January 29, 2022 starting at 9:00AM, just prior to our regular Sunday morning worship service.
