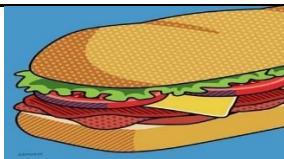
Men's Club

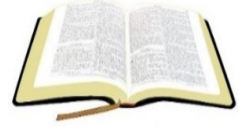
