If you wish to attend, please register your reservation on the orange sign-up sheet on the bulletin board in the hallway or call the church office by November 14th.

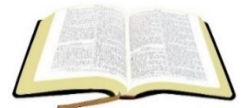
Watch for a stewardship letter and pledge card from the church in early November and prayerfully consider your commitment to God's work here at Trinity.
