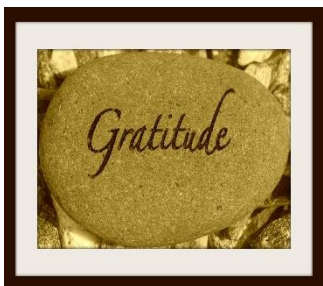


November Faith @ Home Practice Gratitude Journals and Jars
