On Saturday March 11th @ 830 a.m. Lum's Fernbrook there will be a meeting. All men are invited and encouraged to attend.

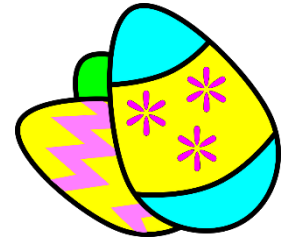


We would like to wish a very happy birthday to Shirley Wolfkeil who is celebrating her 93rd birthday today, March 5th.
