

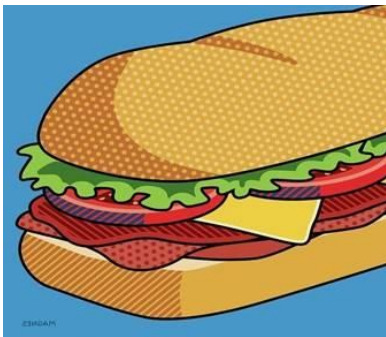
Mark your calendars for a Spring Fellowship Potluck that will be held after worship service Sunday April 16th. More details to follow.

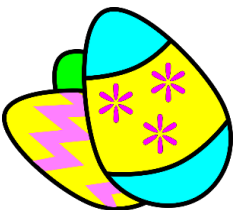

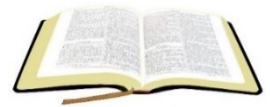
