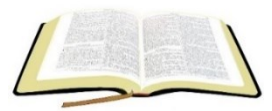

There is a flower chart sign-up sheet in hallway for anyone wishing to honor a loved one. The cost of flowers is \$35 per week so please plan accordingly.



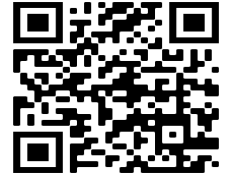
