The regular meeting of the Session was held on December 13, 2021 at Trinity Presbyterian Church, Dallas, PA. The following items were discussed and acted upon by the Session.

#### 1. New Members:

- a. On December 19, 2021, the Session approved the baptism of Kristina Coy, Zachary Coy and Abbie Coy scheduled for December 19, 2021.
- b. On December 19, 2021, Trinity welcomed four new members: Joshua Coy, Kristina Coy, Zachery Coy and Abbie Coy all joined by Reaffirmation of Faith.
- 2. Sad Good By: During this month Barbara Rogers and George Flint entered life eternal.
- 3. The Session, with regret, accepted a request from Fred Hunt to transfer his membership to Moosic Presbyterian Church. The motion was unanimously approved with regret by the Session.
- 4. Trinity will hold one service on Christmas Eve at 5:30 that will start upbeat and move to a calm candlelight celebration.

- 5. On December 26, 2021, we held our traditional service of Lessons and Carols. Jessica Starcher was with us to lead the singing, and offer some solos. The readings will be shared with congregation members participating.
- 6. On January 9, 2022 there are plans for an Epiphany pageant where our children will lead us in worship sharing the good news through scripture and song. All families are invited to participate in the worship service.
- 7. The Stewardship Committee sent out the pledge cards during November; followed by hand written notes to every member asking them to pledge to the 2022 drive.
- 8. The Session approved leave for Rev. for January 24 -31, 2022. Jean Biggar is scheduled to fill the pulpit.
- 9. The Session wishes to thank everyone for sending in their 2022 pledges. Please continue to send them in. Our goal is \$100,000. We are almost at \$80,000.

#### 10. From the Board of Deacons:

- a. Fred Hunt completed the Directory. It was sent to Misericordia University, Cougar Prints, for printing. The directory was ready for distribution by Mid-December.
- b. Food Collection Food was collected through November and was delivered to the Food Pantry.
- **c.** Veteran's Day Pictures/Fellowship Nancy Williams put together a poster of Veterans pictures to display at church. Veterans were acknowledged during worship on November 14 followed by food and fellowship after.
- d. November Mission Project The Deacons decided to ask for donations of socks on November 28. The Deacons already have 50 scarves and hats donated from the quilters. The Outreach Committee has toothbrushes and toothpaste to donate to the Veterans.

## 11. The Property Committee:

- a. Held a work day/ clean-up day on November 13, 2021. We had 18 scouts and leaders and eight electrical students and the program director from Johnson College. The scouts worked to clean-up the exterior of the church. The students worked on the LED conversion. The sanctuary is 85% complete.
- b. The Deacons decorated for Christmas on November 13.
- c. The Program Director from Johnson College expressed an interest in returning to work on the light project further.
- 12. The Nominating Committee is in the process of obtaining nominations for the Board of Deacons and the Session. To date, all the vacancies on the

- Board of Deacons have been filled. Two of the three vacancies on the Session have also been filled.
- 13. The Session wishes to thank the Men's Club for their gift of \$2,000 to the General Fund. In addition, the Women of Trinity will donate \$1,000 to the 2022 General Budget.
- 14. Every year, the Session is requested to elect new members to The Frank Linden Howorth and Margaret Jones Howorth Memorial Trust and the Endowment Committee. This year, the Session made the following selections.
  - a. Wayne Williams, Class of 2023, to replace a vacancy on the Endowment Committee.
  - b. Sandy Peoples, Class of 2026, second term on the Endowment Committee
  - c. Jennifer Sgarlat, Class of 2026, second term on The Frank Linden Howorth and Margaret Jones Howorth Memorial Trust.

The Session wishes everyone a very happy and safe 2022. We look forward to seeing everyone in church.
